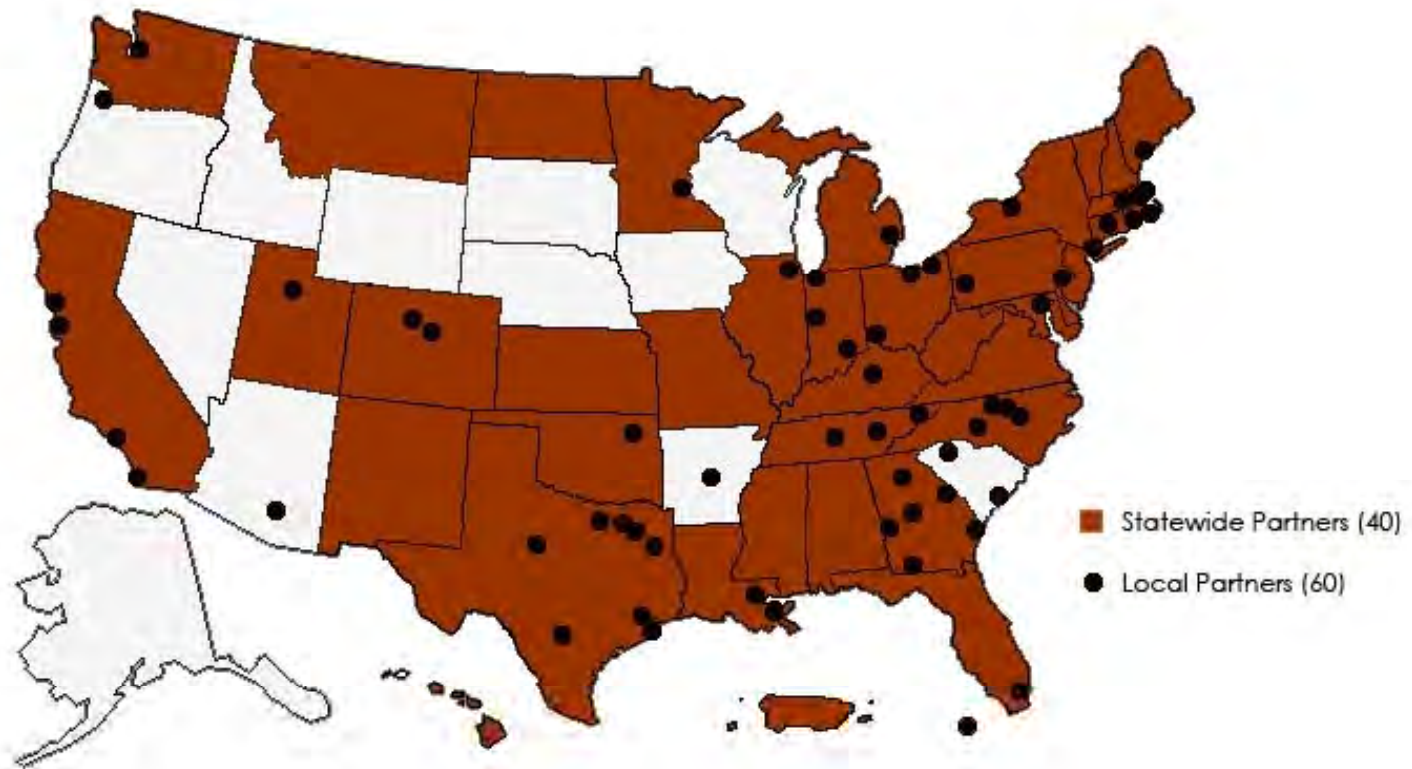

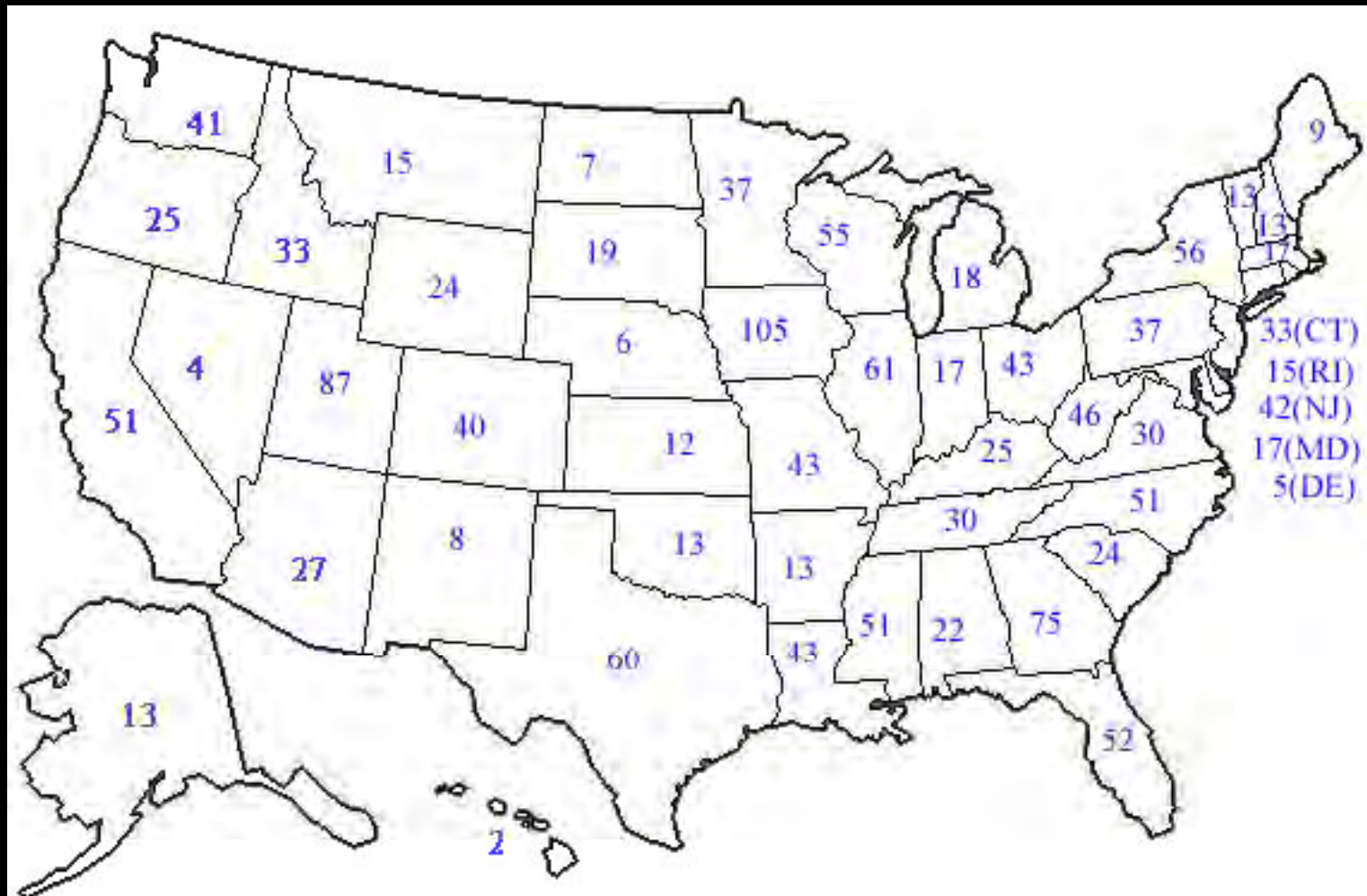

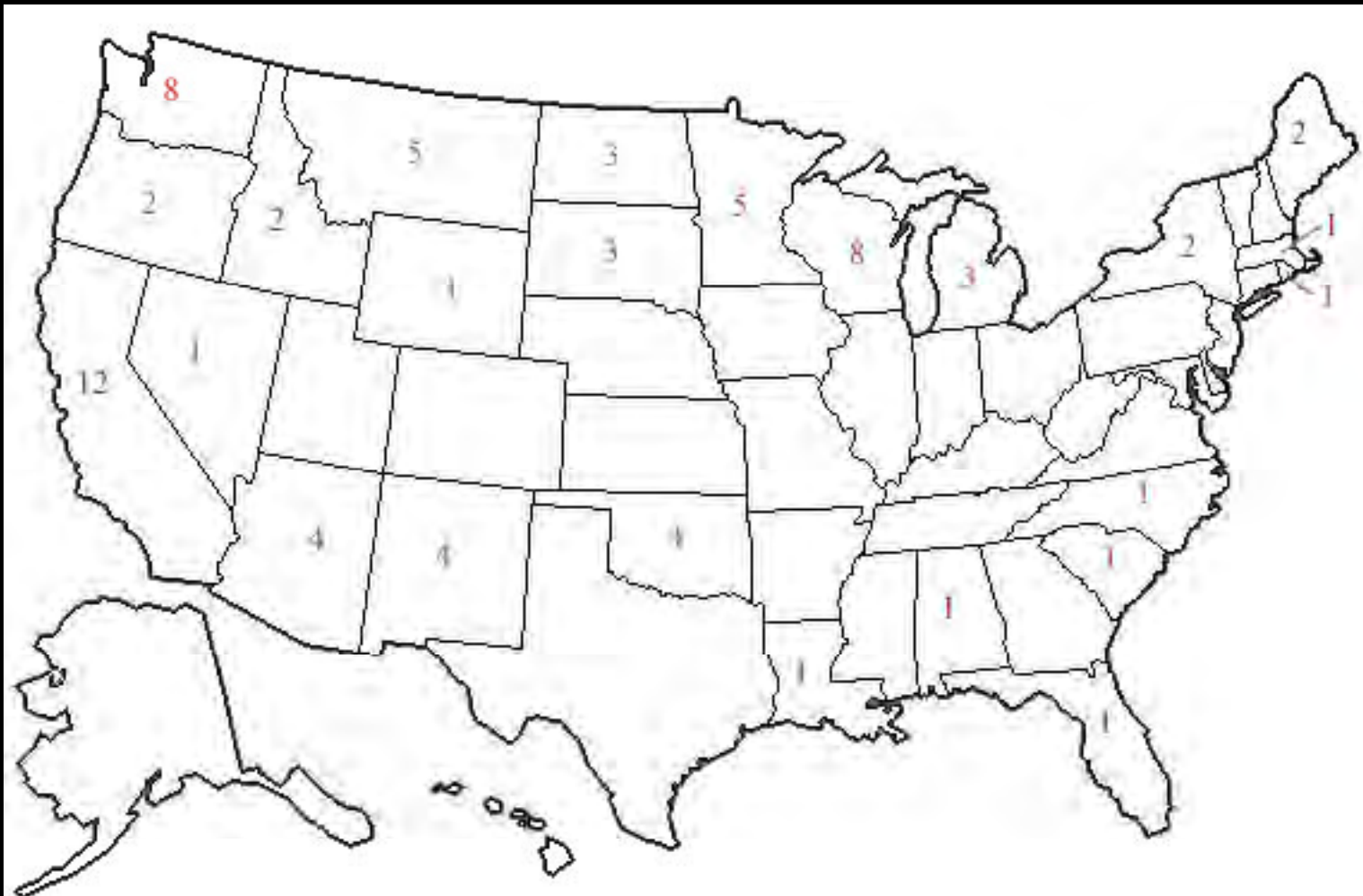
# State Preservation Staff

- **The Network is still incomplete.**
- **There are more CLGs than strong local preservation nonprofits.**
- **Stagnant SHPO funding has taken its toll on ability of SHPOS to be in the field providing assistance especially in the West.**
- **More TPO's has not resulted in more federal funding.**

# Lewis & Clark Trail Heritage Foundation Chapters

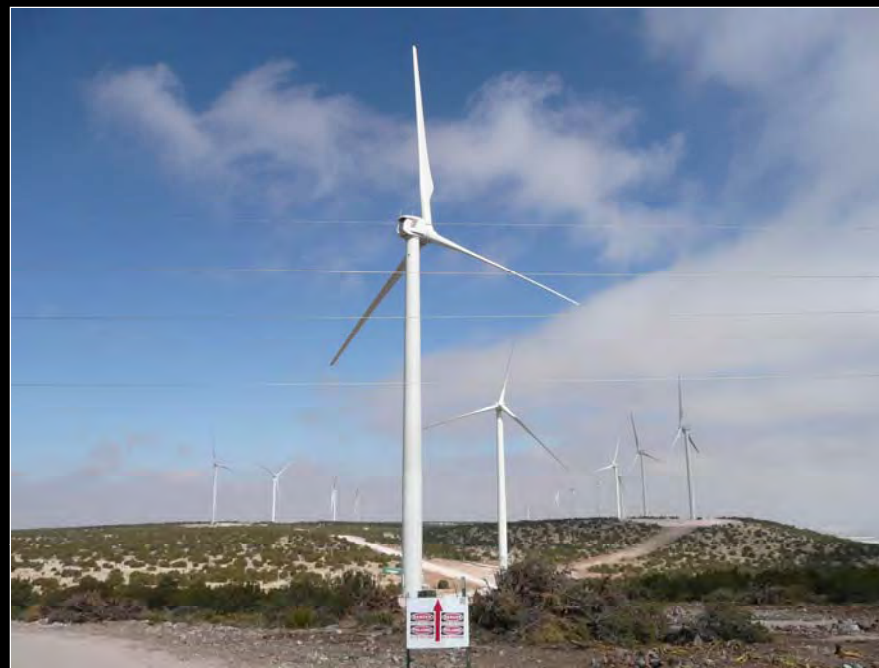
